## **Call for Proposals**

The Dalcroze Society of America invites proposals to present sessions at its **2023 National Conference**, **"Together!,"** January 13-15, 2023 at Baldwin Wallace University in Berea, Ohio.

Proposals are due **September 18, 2022**.

The Conference theme is "Together!" – an opportunity for the community to be together after the pandemic found us separated and often struggling for connection – even for those living in the same city! "Together!" will explore the myriad ways Dalcroze Education enhances group work, whether in a classroom, ensemble, chamber music, performance, or private lesson setting.

Conference sessions will be 45 or 60 minutes in length. We will also offer "Lightning Round" sessions, where presenters will offer a 10-15 minute exercise or idea on a given topic. Presenters may submit up to three proposals for workshops, performances, and/or presentations that relate to "Together!." (If submitting multiple proposals, they should address different areas and different participant experience levels.) We welcome and encourage presenters with all levels of Dalcroze experience and training, including those working in other practices. Preference will be given to proposals that address the theme explicitly or implicitly.

Session content should be accessible to participants at all levels of Dalcroze experience.

  - 4. Outline of the workshop, performance, or presentation (PDF); description of how your presentation expresses the theme of "Together!"
  - 5. Equipment needs and/or technical requirements (piano, space to move, audio, audio-visual, etc.).
